## Estimated Expenses for a MPA-MSES at SPEA

### Tuition and Fees

The total credit hour requirement for the MPA-MSES program is 60 credit hours.

<b>Tuition*</b> (for one 3-credit course)	\$1,548	\$3,806
<b>Mandatory Fees**</b> (per year)	\$1,339	\$1,339
<b>Total Tuition Cost</b> (2 and a half years or 60 credit hours)	<b>\$34,308</b>	<b>\$79,468</b>

<b>Housing</b> (one bedroom apartment off-campus)	\$600-\$800	\$7,200-\$9,600
<b>Food</b> (average of USDA low cost eating)	\$220	\$2,640
<b>Utilities</b> (varies based on personal preferences)	\$100-\$150	\$1,200-\$1,800
<b>Campus Parking Permit</b> (optional)	Up to \$14	\$168
<b>Total Living Cost</b> (average)	<b>\$1,059</b>	<b>\$12,708</b>
