Tuition and Fees

The total credit hour requirement for the MSES programs is 48 credit hours.

Tuition* (for one 3-credit course)	\$1,548	\$3,806
Mandatory Fees** (per year)	\$1,339	\$1,339
Total Tuition Cost (2 years or 48 credit hours)	\$27,446	\$63,574
